







1581-1606 The first period - Foundation Academia Claudiopolitana Societatis Jesu



- The foundation document of the <u>Academia Claudiopolitana Societatis Jesu</u> issued on 12 May 1581 in Vilnius

Second Period of Academia Claudiopolitana Societatis Jesu Reestablishment/Development




Universitas Claudiopolitana located on the current site of UBB

- Romanian University of Cluj
- On the current site of UBB

1945-1989 The University during the communist period



1948 established two universities in Cluj:

- "Victor Babeş" University of Cluj
 - successor of "King Ferdinand I" University
 - teaching in Romanian
- "Bolyai" University of Cluj
 - teaching in Hungarian

<u>1959</u> - the two universities were merged together as the "Babeş-Bolyai" State University of Cluj

1989 Revolution "BABEŞ-BOLYAI" UNIVERSITY OF CLUJ-NAPOCA



- 1989 the name of the university became "BABEŞ-BOLYAI" UNIVERSITY OF CLUJ-NAPOCA
- 2002 it was recognized as the rightful successor of "King Ferdinand I" University
